The IFPW Foundation is a U.S.-based 501(c)3 organization which serves as the charitable and educational arm of the International Federation of Pharmaceutical Wholesalers, Inc. (IFPW). Established in 2012, IFPW Foundation's mission is to support organizations and initiatives that improve the availability of vaccines, medicines and other essential healthcare products and services to patients in need.

The inaugural IFPW Foundation 2021 Virtual Benefit will support a number of critical global activities, including:

[GAVI, The Vaccine Alliance](#)

The IFPW Foundation continues its close collaboration and support of GAVI, the Vaccine Alliance on the development and delivery of its supply chain objectives under Gavi 5.0 (the Alliance's 2021-2025 strategic period) to ensure vaccines reach patients, particularly the underserved.

IFPW's members - through the IFPW Foundation - actively support its dynamic leadership development program, STEP Leadership. This highly-effective course provides EPI managers and other immunization personnel within the public sector with training in foundational management and people skills and, to date, has trained well over 300 managers in the developing world. Historically, included in the course is 4 weeks of online pre-work, a 5-day in person workshop, post-work online, and mentoring/coaching by a private sector partner to support the completion of a capstone project. Through the active participation of its members, the IFPW Foundation has made a significant impact, particularly in sub-Saharan Africa.

As the world-wide pandemic continues, the safety and practicality of face-to-face training remains challenging. Therefore, GAVI and IFPW Foundation have pivoted to focus on two timely and very important initiatives:

[Virtual STEP Leadership \(vSTEP\)](#) - With travel in most underdeveloped nations at a standstill, IFPW and GAVI, along with other key partners are rapidly developing a virtual version of the very successful STEP Leadership tool. Funding is critical to implementation in these environments, where internet access and stable electricity can be sporadic, and successful capstone projects by class participants (with support from private sector coaches) are critical to successful learning.

[COVID Vaccine Planning & Leadership](#) - IFPW Foundation will support supply chain design/redesign activities and bring the latest supply chain innovations to public sector immunization programs aimed at the COVID pandemic and associated responses. As support-eligible COVAX Facility countries begin vaccinating their populations in challenging environments and geographies, planning and leadership is essential to success. Without successful vaccination campaigns in these countries, health outcomes will be severely compromised, and already shortened life expectancies will get worse.

The IFPW Foundation is honored to work with GAVI as our key partner in these important endeavors, which have proven to be more important than ever in the current pandemic .

[Fight the Fakes Alliance](#)

The IFPW Foundation, has been deeply involved as a partner with the Fight the Fakes Alliance (FtF), a multi-stakeholder not-for-profit association aimed at raising awareness and influencing change surrounding the global proliferation of substandard and falsified medicines. IFPW Foundation has served as Secretariat for FtF and has helped lead the establishment of this Alliance as a "certified multi stakeholder alliance" based in Geneva, Switzerland.

The substandard and falsified medicines phenomenon is a global worldwide issue and is disproportionately higher in low- and middle-income countries where 1 in 10 medicines are thought to be either substandard or falsified. Nearly 170,000 children die annually of falsified pneumonia medicines, and substandard/falsified anti-malarials cause as many as 116,000 deaths from malaria annually in sub-Saharan Africa.

IFPW Foundation, through its partnership with the FtF Alliance, is uniquely positioned to scale up action to prevent falsified medicines from endangering people's health and well-being, and remains fully committed to working with FtF to give a voice to those who have been personally impacted by falsified and substandard medicines and collaborate with other stakeholders to fight this global issue. Sadly, the current pandemic has also increased the incidence of fake / counterfeited COVID therapies and supplies so additional resources and efforts will be necessary to protect individuals and maintain trust in healthcare systems.
